US Equestrian Combined Driving Year in Review

Thank you all so much for welcoming me into your driving community. While combined driving might be a small section of equestrian sports, our people are certainly the best! I wanted to highlight some of the notable achievements from USEF Combined Driving this year.

The <u>USEF Emerging Driver Program</u> hosted a record number of seven clinics this year with two in Ohio, New Jersey, Missouri, Colorado, New York, and Washington. The team of <u>Tracy Bowman, Bob Giles, and Diane Kastama</u> placed second in the FEI Para Driving World Championship in Exloo, Netherlands. Finally, we hosted six USEF Combined Driving National Championships across three states to support growing our sport right at home. Looking ahead to 2024, we have added both a Para Driving National Championship and a Training Level National Championship to expand our footprint.

On the world stage, U.S. athletes are gearing up for the <u>FEI Driving World</u> <u>Championship for Four-in-Hand Horses</u> in Hungary and the <u>FEI Driving World</u> <u>Championship for Single Horses in France</u>. The overall goals for USEF Combined Driving the next five years are to see our able-bodied teams take a podium at an FEI World Championship, double the number of licensed competitions in the country, grow combined driving with the U25 audience, and continue to provide opportunities for the advancement of our world class para driving athletes. All of this would not be possible without your support and dedication to combined driving. Thank you for a wonderful year!


