The 2024 Olympic Games Selection Procedures for Eventing have been published and can be found on the US Equestrian website here. The 2024 Olympic Games will take place in Paris, Fance with the Eventing portion of the Games taking place July 26-29, 2024, on the Palace of Versailles grounds.

Application Information: Before you begin your application, you must complete the following items: Athlete:

- Active USEF Competing Membership
- FEI Registration

Horse(s):

- FEI Registration
- USEF Lifetime Recording
- Commonly Ridden Horses in order to add your horse to the application, they must first be added to your <u>Commonly Ridden Horses</u> page within your Athlete Dashboard.

Application Deadline and Fees: Deadlines are enforced without exception. Upon receipt of your application and fee, you and your horse owner(s) will receive a confirmation email with the date your application was received, and horse(s) included on the application. If you do not receive a confirmation email regarding your application, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to contact Gemma Stobbs (gstobbs@usef.org) to determine if it has been received.

Athletes wishing to be considered for the U.S. Eventing Team must complete an online application with the application fee through their <u>USEF Athlete Dashboard</u>. Applications will be charged seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per application at the time of submission. No applications will be accepted after February 23, 2024, at 11:59PM EST.

Additional Horse(s) may be added as late additions to an Athlete's application at any time until **April 22**, **2024**, **at 11:59PM EST**. Following the close of applications on February 23, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. EST, a late fee of three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350.00) will be charged per horse addition at the time of submission.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the owner(s) of the horses they apply with have read and understand the Selection Process and Procedures, which can be found on the US Equestrian website here.
