Re: 2021 U.S. FEI Jumping Calendar Policies and Procedures adjustments due to COVID-19

Due to continued uncertainty of the COVID-19 pandemic, USEF has made the following adjustments to the U.S. FEI Calendar Policies and Procedures document for 2021 until further notice. These adjustments are due to the FEI's decision to continue with shortened timelines and to give the Federation the ability to respond accordingly to these adjustments.

Late Applications and Modifications:

CSI4* and CSI5* - will be considered if received a minimum of 14 weeks prior to event (from 22 weeks)
CSI3* - will be considered if received a minimum of 10 weeks prior to event (from 22 weeks)
CSI1* and CSI2* - will be considered if received a minimum of 6 weeks prior to event (from 18 weeks)

Review Procedure:

USEF will continue to notify OCs (FEI and Level 6) that have an event on the date of the late application or modification, one week prior to, and one week following. OCs concerned will have four (4) days to provide detailed comments regarding the proposed late application or modification to the calendar.

Fees:

The current procedure allows the CEO the discretion to waive USEF fees for Late Applications, Modifications, and Cancellations in exceptional circumstances.
